SPOTLIGHT ON PROGRAMS

While online classes and take-home activities dominated children's programming in 2021, **inlibrary activities rebounded** in 2022. Kids returned in droves to enjoy 147 live storytimes, two outdoor concerts, and even mini-golf. Many adults preferred to get their library programs online in 2022 and the library obliged. Of special note were events with environmental superstars Doug Tallamy and Suzanne Simard and a tour of Amsterdam's new STRAAT street art museum. Our program on Dogs in the Ancient World drew **live viewers from 26 countries.** Use of the library's YouTube channels rocketed this year, extending the reach and longevity of our online programming.
